Language support within Impressario

Impressario displays PDF documents of all languages, including Unicode/ double-byte characters. However, there are certain characters that are not supported in version 2.0 for text operations, such as:

- manually editing the text of form fields,
- setting the text of form fields, using `SetFields()`,
- retrieving text, using the `GetPageText()` or `GetSelectedText()`, or
- using the `Find()` method

The following table lists the characters, which are not supported on Windows and Mac, and their ASCII codes.
